Subject:	Transit Benches		

RECOMMENDATION:

That Council authorize administration to enter into discussions with Creative Outdoor Advertising (COA) for the installation of benches at transit bus stops.

REPORT:

The Town has been approached by COA to install benches with advertising at various bus stop locations. COA has over 30 years of experience in providing this service and is working in over 240 communities across North America. Currently COA has a contract with the City of Windsor to provide benches along the Transit Windsor routes. This would be a logical extension, hence the recommendation, to pursue discussions with COA as opposed to issuing a RFP. This approach would be consistent with advertising on/in the buses. As Council may recall, as part of the transit approval, authorization was also given to enter into discussion with Street-seen to wrap the buses being purchased by the Town. As Transit Windsor currently has a contract with Street-seen, it was deemed appropriate for the Town to use the same company. The following outlines the key components of their proposal:

- 1. COA will install benches at no cost to the Town. The installation will include any concrete pad that may be required.
- COA will conduct an audit of the transit route and make recommendations for bench locations.
 The Town will have final approval authority for where benches may be located.
- 3. COA will be responsible for all aspects of advertising to be placed on the benches. Sponsors will be a monthly fee to advertise on the benches.
- 4. A percentage of the benches will be made available to the Town at no cost for advertising purposes.
- COA will conduct inspections of each bench to clean, repair, and maintain the units and the immediate area around them.
- 6. Program would provide for a revenue stream to the Town in the amount of approx. 5%
- 7. Town will have control and approval rights over all sponsorship messages.

- 8. All units are GPS coded and will allow Town staff to monitor COA's inspection program.
- 9. The benches being proposed by COA is the Lexington (copy attached) which would be consistent with new installations along Transit Windsor routes.
- 10. Attached is a copy of the PowerPoint Presentation that was given to administration/

Based on the above, it is recommended the staff further its discussion with COA for the purposes of drafting an agreement.
