Report

Under the authority of municipal By-law No. 6500 certain municipal officials are appointed by Council as Provincial Offences Officers for the purpose of enforcing the provisions of regulatory by-laws of the Corporation of the Town of LaSalle.

The Deputy Fire Chief position has delegated authority and responsibility for the enforcement of various municipal by-laws, in addition to Ontario Fire Code matters. It is therefore recommended that Deputy Fire Chief Richard Malott be appointed as a Provincial Offences Officer for the Town of LaSalle, as set out in Schedule "A" of by-law No. 6500, as amended, and further that the appointment of Fire Chief Dave Sutton be rescinded.
