The Corporation of the Town of LaSalle

By-law Number 8613

A By-Law to authorize the acquisition of certain lands for a second fire station development within the Town of LaSalle.

Whereas the Corporation wishes to construct a second fire station on the west side of Matchette Road, north of Laurier Drive;

And whereas it is necessary to acquire the land located at the northwest corner of the intersection of Laurier Drive and Matchette Road, with said land being more particularly described in Schedule "A" attached hereto, to accommodate the construction of a second fire station;

Now therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Town of LaSalle hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That Administration and the Town Solicitor are hereby authorized to take any and all steps necessary to acquire ownership of the lands described on Schedule "A", attached hereto, including proceeding with an Application for Approval to Expropriate Land under the Expropriations Act, which lands are required for the construction of a second fire station on that portion of land at the northwest corner of the intersection of Laurier Drive and Matchette Road.
- 2. **That** this By-Law shall come into full force and effect on the final passing thereof.
