

**The Corporation of the Town of LaSalle**

**By-Law Number 8658**

Being a By-law to adopt the Budget for the year 2022.

**Whereas** administrative personnel have prepared a proposed budget which has been reviewed and scrutinized by the members of the Town of LaSalle Council;

**And whereas** Section 290 of *The Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25*, as amended provides that the Council of a local municipality shall, after the adoption of estimates for the year pass a by-law to levy a separate tax rate on the assessment in each property class;

**And whereas** the 2022 current operating budget of \$52,005,900 gross expenditures, net expenditures of \$45,481,100 of which \$40,131,900 will be recovered through the general taxation;

**And whereas** the 2022 current water operating budget of \$6,261,300 gross expenditures, which are fully recovered through user charges;

**And whereas** the 2022 current waste water operating budget of \$4,797,200 gross expenditures, which are fully recovered through user charges;

**And whereas** the 2022 capital budget of \$32,582,000 to be funded via various sources;

**And whereas** the effect of the budget will result in a municipal tax rate change to residential ratepayers to be 1.75% with an estimated overall tax rate increase of 1.53%;

**Now therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Town of LaSalle enacts as follows:**

1. **That** the 2022 budget as attached hereto as Schedule "A" shall be known and accepted as the "Town of LaSalle 2022 Budget".
2. **That** this By-law shall come into force and take effect on the final passing thereof.

**Read** a first and second time and finally passed this 11<sup>th</sup> day of January 2022.
