

## **The Corporation of the Town of LaSalle**

### **By-law Number 8697**

A By-law to authorize the execution of an Agreement with Canadian Parks and Recreation Association and The Corporation of the Town of LaSalle

**Whereas** Section 9 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. c.25 confers natural person powers on municipalities which includes the power to enter into agreements to exercise its authority under this or any other act;

**And whereas** the Canadian Parks and Recreation Association (“CPRA”) has entered into a partnership with the Canadian Federal Government under the Youth Employment and Skills Strategy Initiative to deliver the CPRA Youth Employment Experience across the country;

**And whereas** The Corporation of the Town of LaSalle (“Corporation”) is participating in the CPRA Youth Employment Experience, and the CPRA will be subsidizing certain jobs or positions within the Corporation;

**And whereas** the Corporation deems it expedient to enter into a CPRA Youth Employment Experience Agreement with the Canadian Parks and Recreation Association, setting out the terms and conditions that have been agreed to with the Corporation;

**Now therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Town of LaSalle hereby enacts as follows:**

1. **That** the Mayor and the Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and empowered on behalf of the Corporation of the Town of LaSalle, to execute a CPRA Youth Employment Experience Agreement with the Canadian Parks and Recreation, a copy of which Agreement is attached hereto and forms part of this By-law and to do such further and other acts which may be necessary to implement the said Agreement.
2. **That** this By-law shall come into full force and effect upon the final passing thereof.
