Subject: LaSalle Small Coast Dock Removal

Recommendation

That the report of the Manager of Engineering dated May 24, 2022 (PW-11-2022) regarding the LaSalle Small Coast Dock Removal be received;

And that Council approve the award of the marina dock removal work to Hotte Marine for the quoted price of \$76,500 plus HST, and fund this amount through the Small Coast Waterfront Experience budget.

Report

Restoration work at the former Westport Marina as part of The LaSalle Small Coast project began in 2021, and as part of the overall phased approach the adjacent parking lot began construction in early 2022. Outside the scope of work for both these phases was the removal of the existing in water metal docks along the marina. The removal of the docks would be a significant visual enhancement to the waterfront and overall Small Coast Project.

Administration requested quotes from a number of contractors within in the community and surrounding area, and below were the quotes received on April 22, 2022.

Hotte Marine: \$76,500 +HST

J&J Marine: \$102,390+HST

Bedrock 42 \$110,000 +HST

Based on the procurement By-Law, and availability of uncommitted funds within the existing Small Coast Parking Lot project, Administration is able to and recommends entering into an agreement with the lowest quoted price from Hotte Marine for the above mentioned price.

There are uncommitted funds available in the Small Coast Waterfront Experience due to cost savings from the tendering and construction of the adjacent Parking lot project.
