And that, Dillon Consulting Ltd. be appointed as the Drainage Engineer for the 6th Concession Drain project.

Report

The Town has received a Section 78 (5) request, dated May 13th, 2022, through the Drainage Act for a minor improvement to the 6th Concession Drain. The request was received from the owner of the property at the north west corner of Laurier and Huron Church. The improvement involves the realignment of a portion of the 6th Concession Drain on the noted property. The purpose of the request for realignment is part of the planning act process for the Lankor Horizons Development Inc. proposed subdivision, known as Laurier Plaza.

As part of the Minor Improvement process through the Drainage Act, notifications are provided only to the owner and the regulating authorities. No costs are assessed to any party other than the requester/owner.

Attached is a sketch showing the approximate location of the proposed realignment.

Administration is recommending the appointment of Dillon Consulting Ltd. as the drainage engineer for this work
