#### Recommendation

That the report of the Director of Public Works (PW-14-2022) regarding the Request for Minor Improvements to the Martin Bergeron Drain be received;

And that, Dillon Consulting Ltd. be appointed as the Drainage Engineer for the project.

### Report

The Town has received a Section 78 (5) request, dated June 10, 2022, through the Drainage Act for a minor improvement to the Martin Bergeron Drain. The request was received from the owner of the property, which is commonly known as the Martin Lane development. The improvement involves the installation of two culverts for new road crossings that are part of the development works.

As part of the Minor Improvement process through the Drainage Act, notifications are provided only to the owner and the regulating authorities. No costs are assessed to any party other than the requester/owner.

Attached are the request submitted, and a sketch showing the approximate location of the proposed realignment.

Administration is recommending the appointment of Dillon Consulting Ltd. as the drainage engineer for this work.
