### **Recommendation**

That the report of the Supervisor of Recreation dated September 10, 2022 (CR-2022-32) regarding road closures for the 2022 Remembrance Day Ceremony be received; and that the closure of Malden Road at Sprucewood Avenue and Normandy Street and Normandy Street at Ellis Street during the 2022 Remembrance Day Ceremony on November 11, 2022 from 10:30 AM to 11:00 AM, and 11:30 AM to 12:00 PM be approved.

### **Report**

The purpose of this report is to advise of the following temporary road closures to execute the 2022 Remembrance Day Parade. The parade is a new addition to the Ceremony for 2022 and will consist of members from the Essex and Kent Scottish Regiment marching. The parade route begins in the Zehrs parking lot and goes west on Ellis Street, south along Malden Road and east on Normandy Street to the Cenotaph. The following road closures will occur for a short time to accommodate the route:

- Malden Road closed at Sprucewood Avenue and Normandy Street
- Normandy Street closed at Ellis Street

LaSalle Police Service will assist the parade route by closing these intersections with their police cruisers. Detours will not be posted due to the short duration of the closure.
