Subject:	2017 Road Reconstruction Project		

RECOMMENDATION:

That Council approve utilizing the 2017 Road Reconstruction Capital budget to carry out the reconstruction of Hazel Street from Bouffard Road to Laurier Drive provided the satellite fire station preferred locations remain at the former Colonial Bishop School site.

REPORT:

As part of the 2017 capital budget, an allocation of \$1.75 million was set aside for the Town to carryout a road reconstruction project within the Town. A road reconstruction project consist of completely reconstructing the existing road to bring the area up to Town current road standards with completely new road base, asphalt, curb and gutter, storm sewers and sidewalks. The following provides a summary of the chosen project for 2017.

Administration is recommending that Hazel Street between Bouffard Road and Laurier Drive be the selected project for 2017. Enclosed is a preliminary sketch of the proposed concept. The estimated construction cost at this time is approx. \$0.9 million.

The preferred location of the satellite fire station is the former Colonial Bishop School site located on Hazel Street between Superior Street and Huron Street. This upgrade on Hazel will provide for more efficient turning movements access and egress into the new fire station site. Furthermore, the reconstruction will provide a benefit to the area and provide for clear two-way traffic on Hazel with connections to Laurier and Bouffard. In addition, the add-on of a sidewalk on Hazel between Laurier and Bouffard will further provide more increased pedestrian safety.

Should Council concur with the recommendation, this project will be communicated to the local residents at the public open house set for May 31 for the satellite fire station.

It is recommended that the 2017 road reconstruction capital budget be allocated to Hazel Street. This shall remain as the preferred project for the 2017 budget if the preferred location for the fire satellite station site remains at the former Colonial Bishop School site.


