RECOMMENDATION:

THAT the report from the Director of Culture and Recreation dated August 2nd, 2017 (C&R 09-17) be RECEVIED for information;

REPORT:

The Town of LaSalle offers various programming for residents during the summer operations including Day Camps and aquatics. The success of these programs have been highlighted in this report to demonstrate the services being enjoyed by residents.

The Day Camps have been at full capacity with registration reaching on average 180 - 190 kids daily. This exceeds the participant totals from 2016 which saw a high of 120 – 140 daily on average. Registration totals highlight the popularity and reputation of the camps and demonstrates success with return customers who continually participate daily, weekly and annually. We have increased participation by 880 to date. That is a 28% growth in day camp registration.

Staff have been recognized for their energetic and compassionate approach to their daily tasks with the children. We have received positive feedback from families throughout the summer regarding the councilors, Team Leaders and Supervisor.

The addition of the Splash Pad has been incorporated into the weekly routine of camp allowing for a fun opportunity for campers to cool down during warm camp days. There has been an abundance of feedback from families who are happy with the splash pad being incorporated into day camp activities.

AQUATICS

The aquatics program is also seeing some good results with registration and programming totals. The participation total numbers will be affected with the closure in August and September while repairs and maintenance are being completed on the indoor pool.

The Vollmer aquatics will be seeing lower numbers as the pool closure does not allow for a full session of M/W lessons for the month of August (simply private lessons available). The Recreation Department attempted to run M/W lessons at the Outdoor Pool as an alternative to keep registration numbers equivalent and there was little to no interest. All classes were cancelled due to low enrolment.

The outdoor pool started session 3 this Monday (July 31st). There is one more session beginning on August 14th. When classes are cancelled due to low registration numbers, their corresponding instructor expense is eliminated. The Final session will increase registration totals for summer aquatics.

A summer total for programming will be presented in a report in September displaying registration numbers and comparisons to 2016.
