### **Recommendation**

That the report of the Manager of Engineering dated April 14, 2024 (PW-15-2024) regarding the Cabot Street Watermain Rehabilitation be received;

And that Council approves the award of the Watermain Contract to Major Construction (2010) Ltd. for the bid price of \$386,846.50 plus HST;

And that this amount be funded from the 2024 Watermain Replacement Project, which is part of the Approved 2024 Capital Budget.

### **Report**

The 2024 Watermain work consists of roughly 550 meters of 200mm watermain replacement and restoration along Cabot Street from Wyoming to Delmar (including cul-de-sacs).

The tender closed on April 26<sup>th</sup>, 2024 and we received the following prices (excluding HST)

Major construction (2010) Ltd. \$386,846.50

J.C.S Construction Inc. \$530,780.00

Rudak Excavating Inc. \$559,930.00

Nevan Construction Inc. \$564,750.00

SheaRock Construction Group Inc. \$579,000.00

D'Amore Construction (2000) Ltd. \$596,136.00

Sherway Contracting (Windsor) Ltd. \$834,825.80

Based on the tender prices, Administration is recommending this contract be awarded to Major Constructon for the above bid price.

Construction schedule is expected to start in June and be completed prior to August 2024.
