**Subject:** CR-2024-16 Updates to LaSalle Affordable Recreation Policy

### **Recommendation**

That the report of the Supervisor of Recreation dated May 31, 2024 (CR-2024-16) regarding updates to the LaSalle Affordable Recreation Policy be received;

And that the updated LaSalle Affordable Recreation Policy be adopted, and the previous version be repealed.

### **Report**

The LaSalle Affordable Recreation Policy is used to identify and communicate the Town's policy for allocation of funding to be used for affordable recreation opportunities for LaSalle residents. The policy was due for revision as part of the regular policy update cycle, with the last revision being in September 2022 (CR-2022-33).

The policy has been updated with the following changes:

- Addition of point 4.1.3 (f) outlining documentation requirements for new residents or residents who have changed addresses.
- Addition of section 4.2.2 outlining that the Town does not retroactively award funding and all affordable recreation registrations must be approved by the Town.
- Addition of section 4.3.3 outlining that in some instances, the participant may be required to pay more than ten percent due to the nature of the program they wish to participate in.
