RECOMMENDATION

That the report provided from the Chief Administrative Officer dated March 3, 2020 (CAO-01-2020) regarding the proposed LaSalle Police Service Electronic Sign BE RECEIVED and that Town Council prohibit the installation of the sign.

Last evening at the LaSalle Police Services Board Meeting, LPS received a "formal letter of endorsement" from the LaSalle Police Services Board to move forward with a presentation to LaSalle Town Council in relation to our proposed Marquis (Electronic Sign). I note that in CAO Milicia's report, it states "*Further to the Council question, Administration reviewed the proposal from the LaSalle Police Service*". Could you please clarify this because as previously stated, we have only made such a presentation to the LaSalle Police Services Board and could not move forward to Council until we first obtained LPSB approval / endorsement.

As a result, the LaSalle Police Service would respectfully request time to properly prepare a presentation and have a delegation present in order to fully demonstrate the merits of this extremely innovative initiative to Council. In the spirit of fairness and transparency, I would ask that consideration be given to postponing this agenda item and moving it to the next Council meeting as LPS was never notified that this would be an agenda item at the March 10th, 2020 TOL Council meeting.

Should this request not be granted, I would then respectfully request the opportunity to have an LPS delegation attend this evening's TOL Council meeting to provide a presentation on this matter.

In closing, I thank you and Council for their consideration in this matter and look forward to your reply.
